DAV Public School, Bazpur has started virtual classes from Nursery to XII for all subjects w.e.f 26<sup>th</sup> March 2020 to ensure the continuous learning of students.

For virtual classes, Home-Work, Co-Curricular Activities, Online Tests/Quizzes, we have been using some of the popular technology tools like Zoom Cloud Meeting, Edmodo Assignment App, WhatsApp, Google Drive, Google Forms, Google Sheets, You-tube.

We have provided instructions/guide steps for using these applications to students as well as to the teachers. Our teachers interacted with students at any time for providing study material, clearing their doubts and queries regarding studies.

**For Online video conferencing platform,** Our teachers have been using **Zoom Cloud Meeting** application, which was providing a realistic atmosphere for a teachers and students during class. In Zoom Cloud Meet, teachers have taught the students through Zoom's white board or their own white/green boards, teachers shared their chapter PDF, Notes, Power Point Presentations, Youtube Videos during class to teach the students effectively. At the end of class, students were allowed to ask their queries to teachers. Teachers maintained the record of students attendance for every class.

Yoga is the way of living towards a healthy mind in a healthy body. It is the necessity for students as well as for the teachers to stay fit, physically and mentally during this crisis situation. To keep this in mind, School planned to organize the Yoga session every Sunday through Zoom meet only. It was well appreciated by parents.

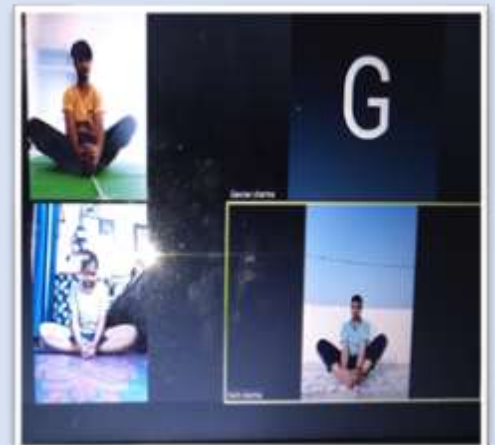

**VIRTUAL CLASS THROUGH ZOOM MEETING**



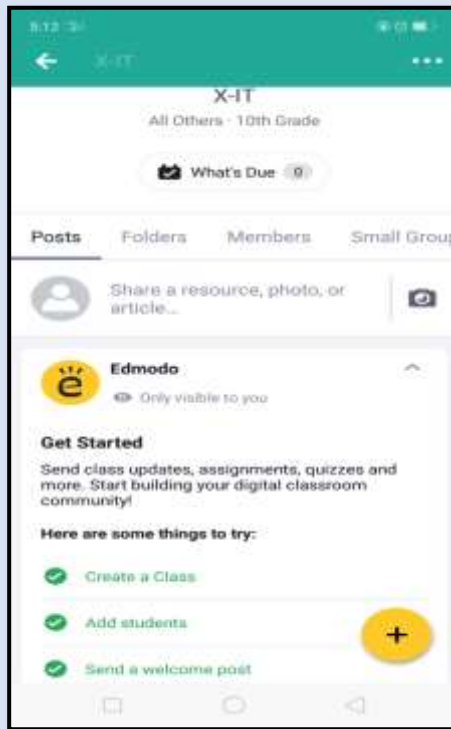
**YOGA SESSION THROUGH ZOOM MEETING**

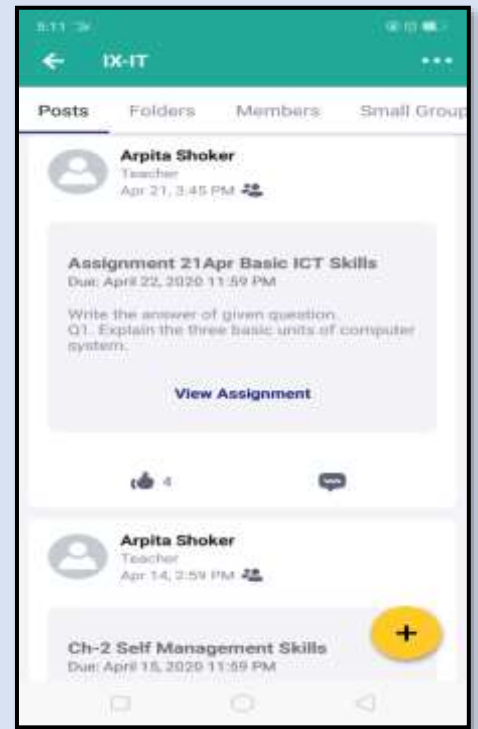
Teacher shared their notes, assignments, presentations with students through this assignment app. Students were asked to submit their assignments on Edmodo by the due date of assignment completion.

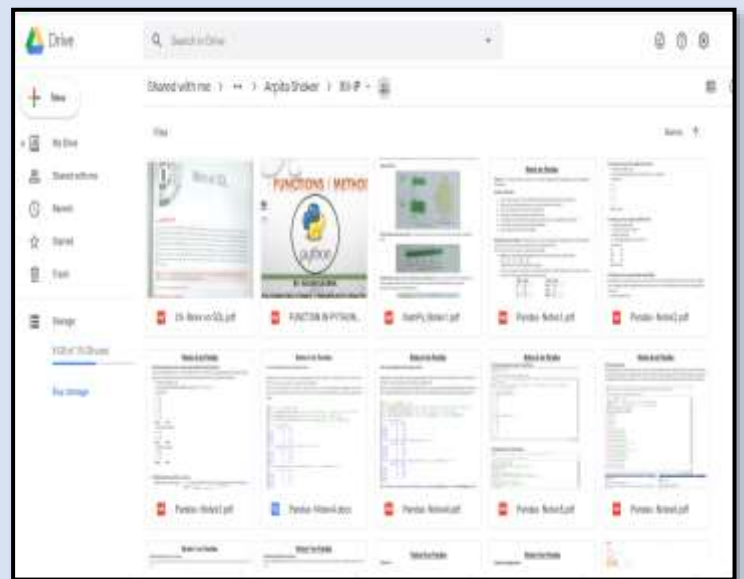
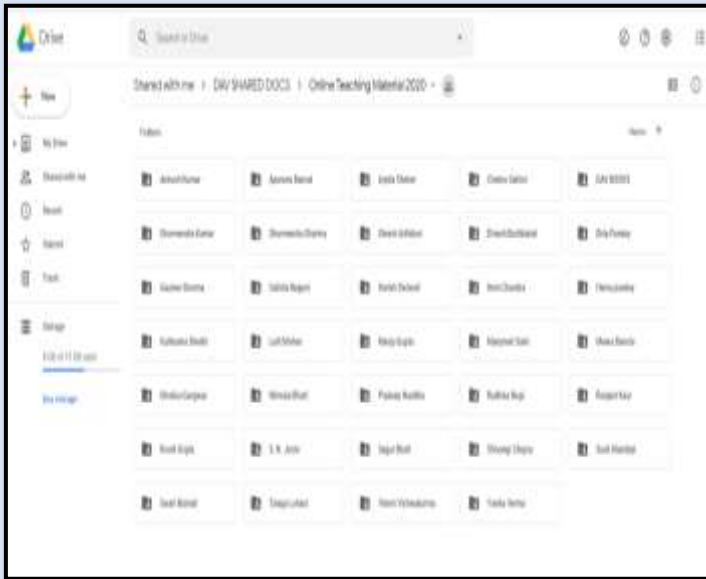

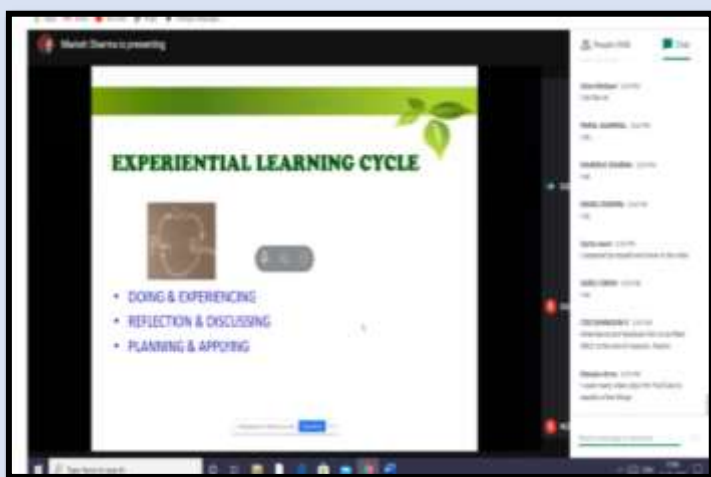
**WATERING THE PLANTS ACTIVITY**
